The Somi net clipper on display covers product weights between 250 and 800 grams. The portfolio is complemented by the CGC net machine, which can handle packaging weights of up to 3,000 grams. Trade visitors were impressed by the low energy consumption, the possibility of retrofitting existing systems and the high level of process reliability.

‘Poly-clip System demonstrated at Fruit Logistica 2026 that sustainable net packaging has now reached a high level of maturity,’ adds Dr Giehl. ‘Clip packaging is
